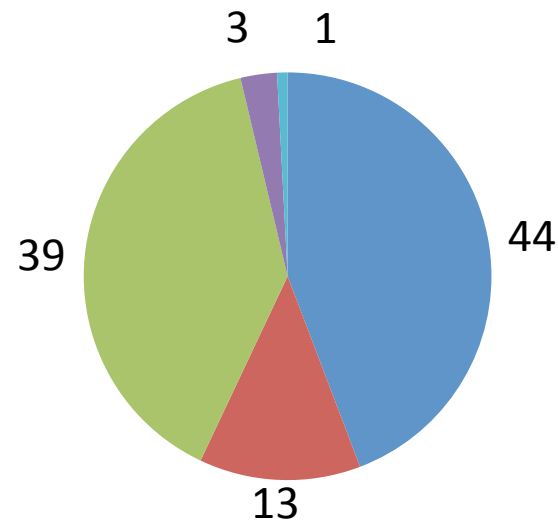

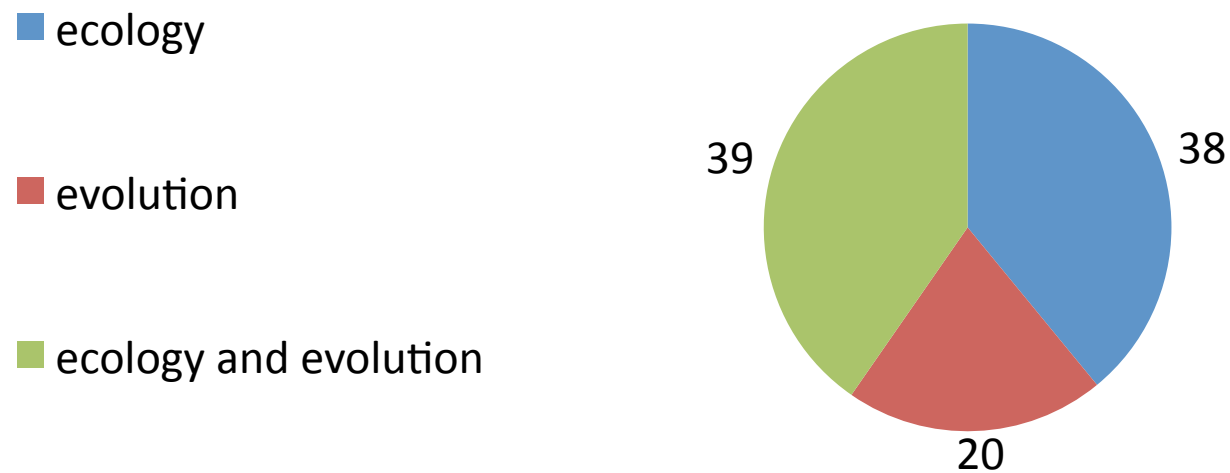

- industry scientist

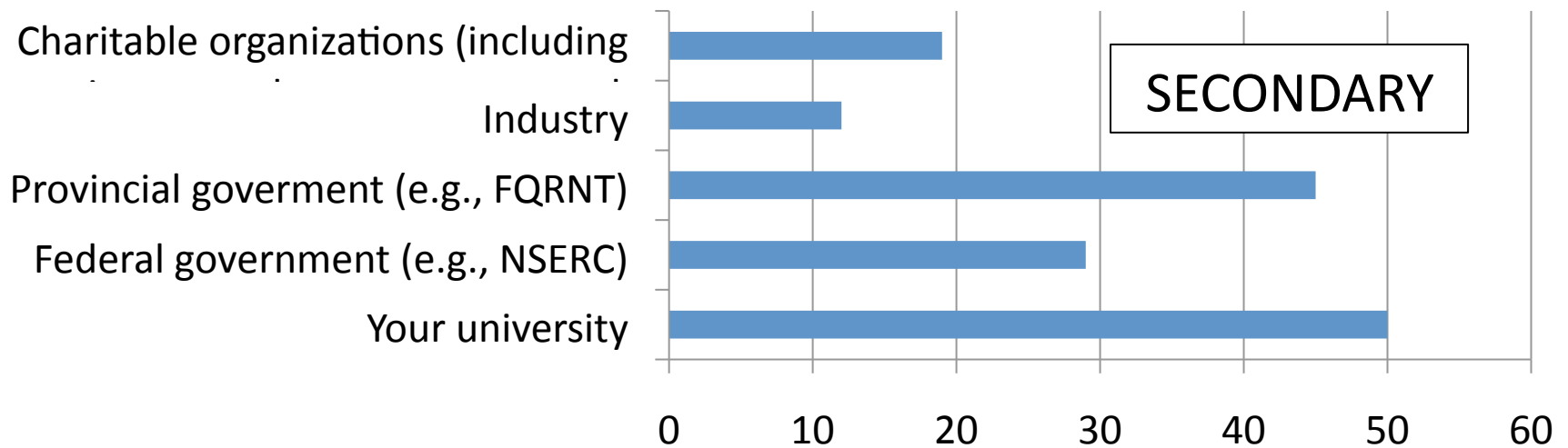
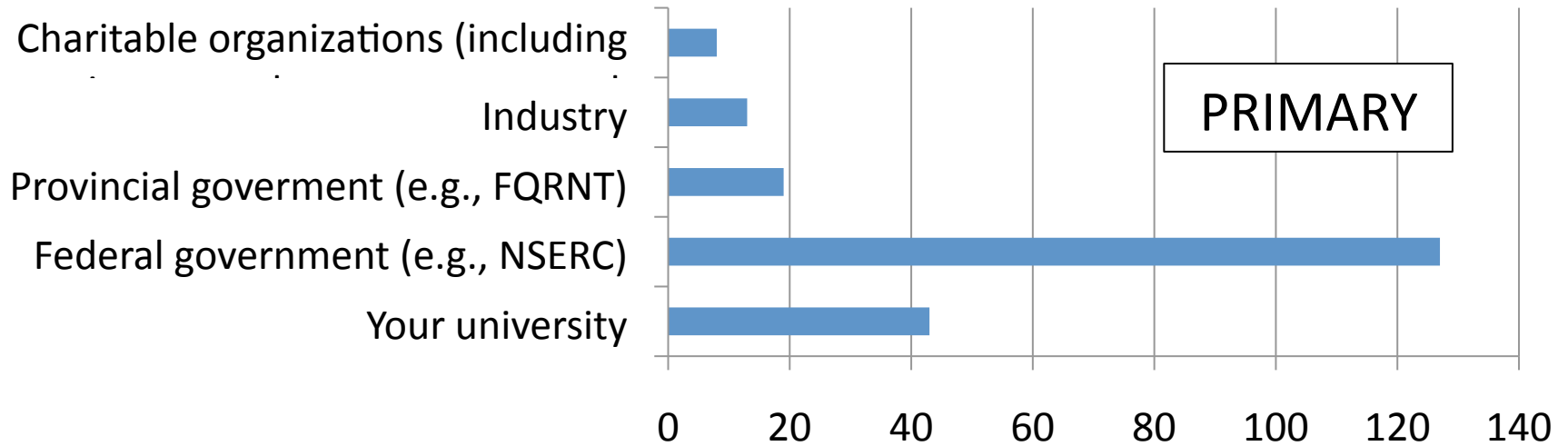


Q2. Which of the following best describes your basic field of study?



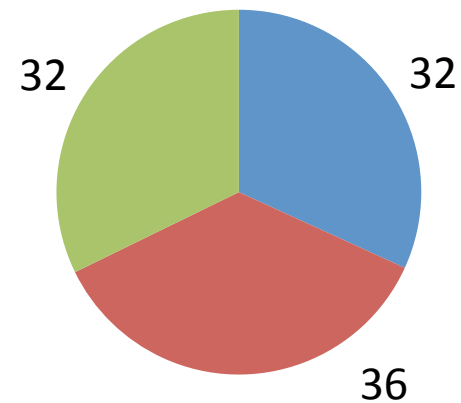
17 (7%) "OTHER": various "behaviour", various "paleo", various "genetics", conservation, environment, entomology, biogeography

Q4. What is the primary reason you joined CSEE?

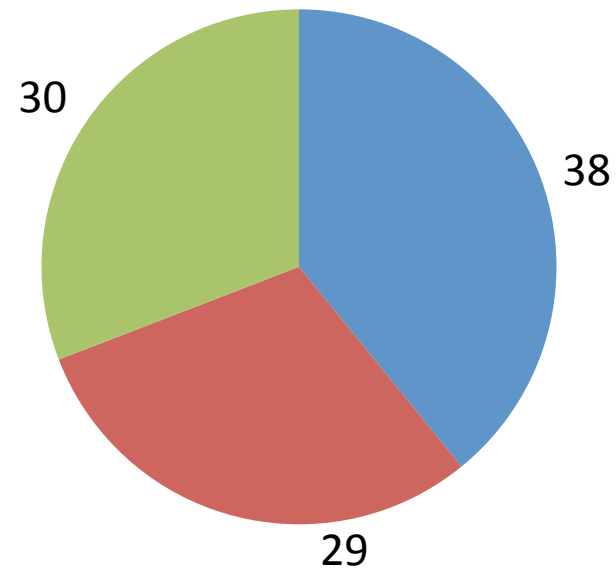
- I attended one of the annual meetings

Q5. Our annual meeting is usually held in May. Which of the following best describes your opinion about this timing?

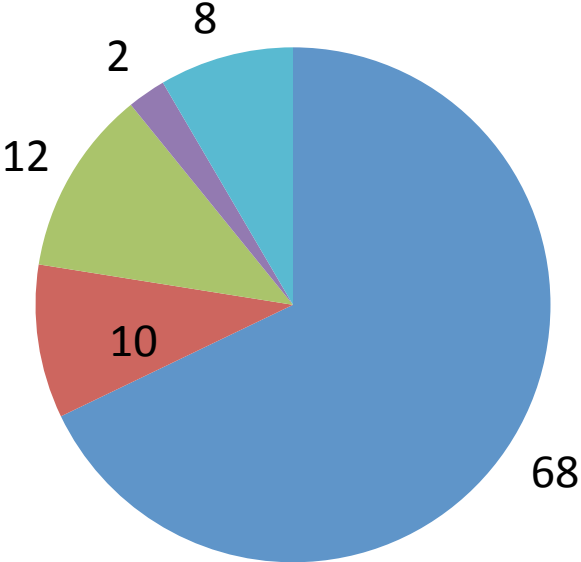
- I would like the meetings to stay in May.

31 comments: Most common is complaining that May is field season.

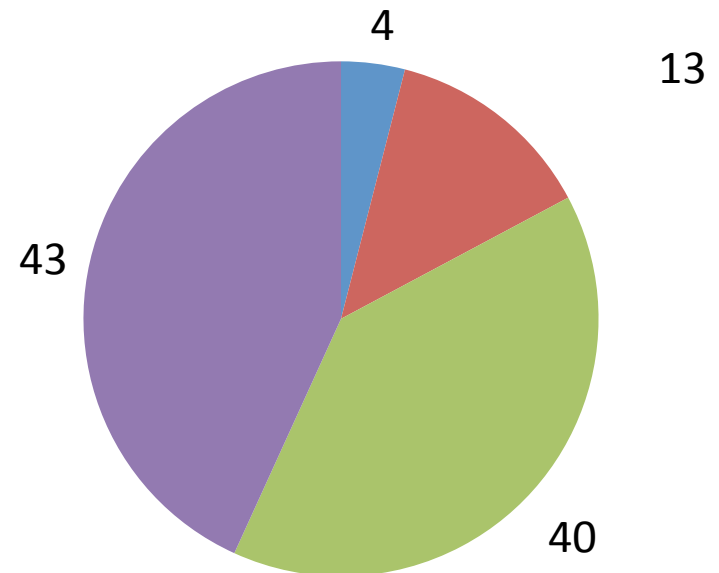
Q6. Which statement best represents your opinion on the frequency and location of the annual meeting?

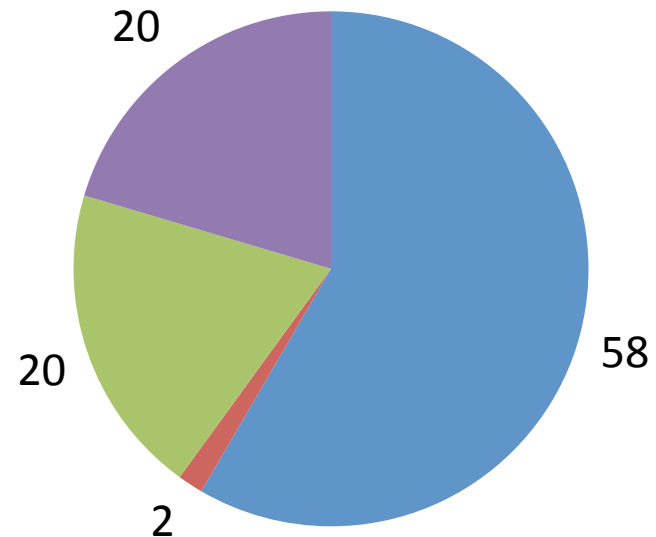
Q7. Which of the following best describes your opinion on the balance between student and faculty participation at our annual meeting ?

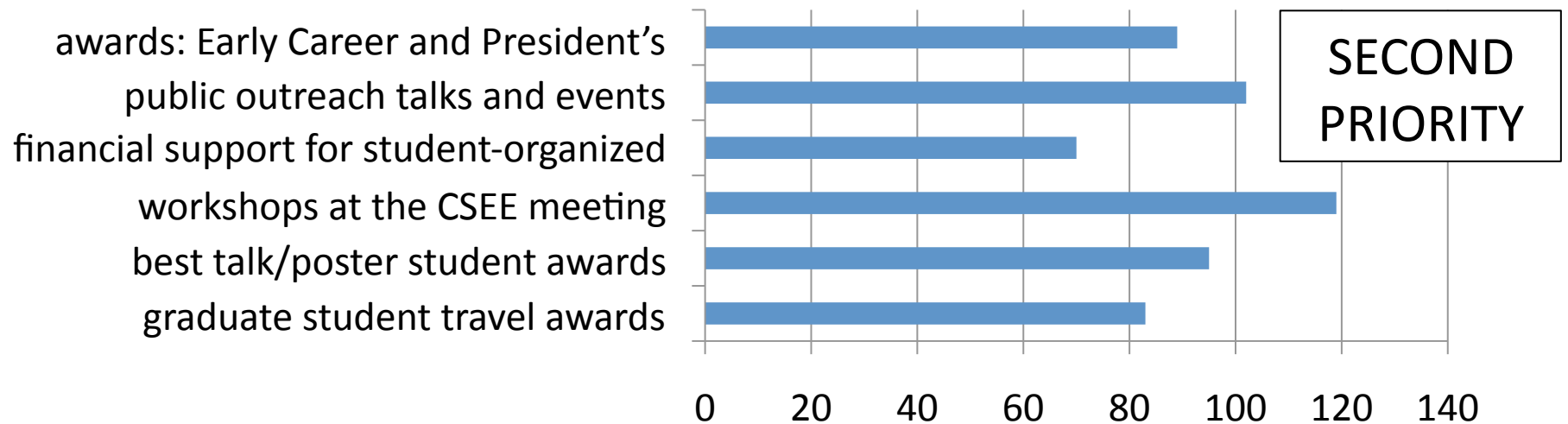
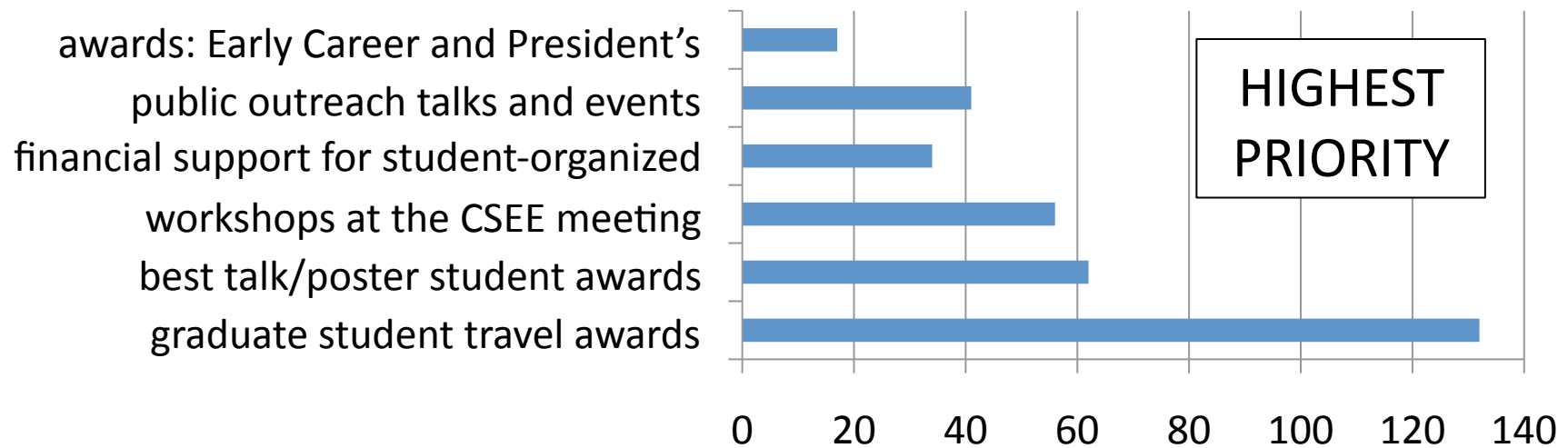


Q8. How do you think CSEE/SCEE should be involved with advocacy and efforts to influence political decision-making?

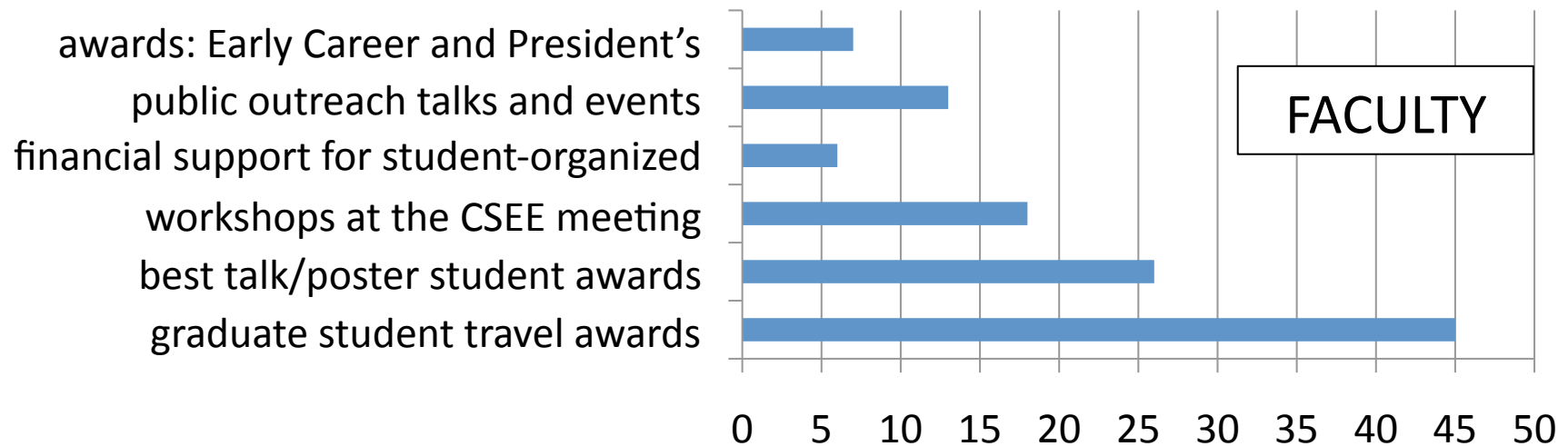
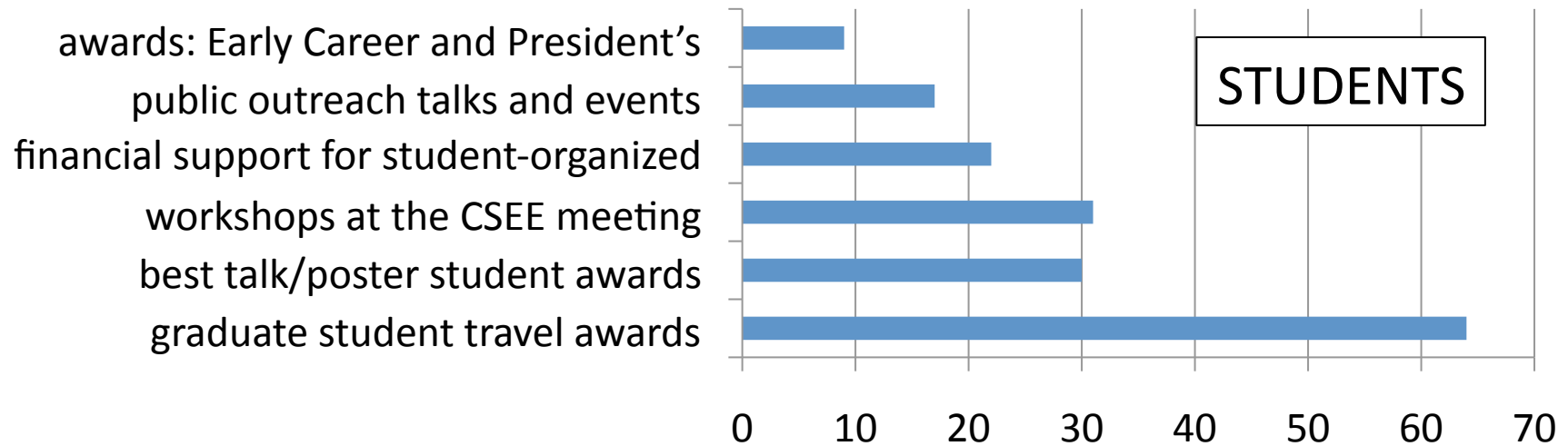

Q9. Please indicate which CSEE activities you think are good investments and you would like to see continued?

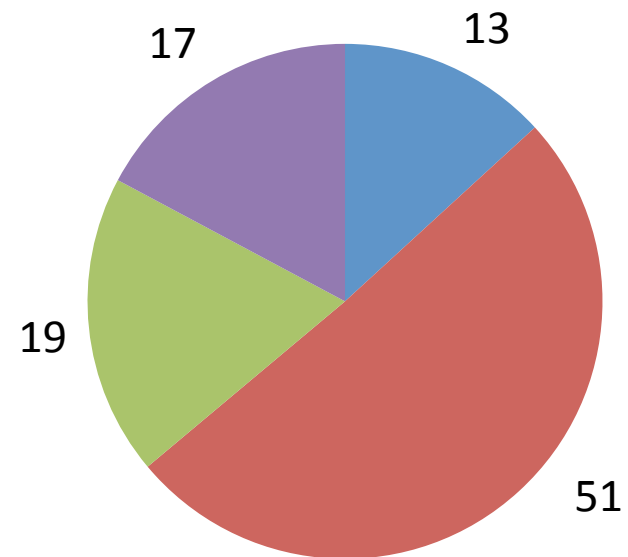
